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## **Monday, September 18, 2023:** *Transition Planning and Section 5 of the IEP* by OCECD

- This workshop will introduce attendees to post-secondary transition planning for students with disabilities and provide an overview of Section 5 of the IEP. Use of Age-Appropriate Transition Assessments (AATAs) will also be discussed.

## **Monday, October 16, 2023:** *Graduation Requirements and Extended Eligibility; Deferring Diploma for Students with Disabilities* by ODE

- This workshop will outline current graduation requirements and pathways/options to graduation for students with disabilities and discuss eligibility and requirements for students to defer a diploma and continue to receive education and related services on the IEP.

## **Monday, November 20, 2023:** *Preparing for Employment: Vocational Rehabilitation Services for Transition Age Youth* by DRO

- This workshop will introduce attendees to vocational rehabilitation services in Ohio for transition age youth, as well as summer youth work experiences, non-permanent job development, pre-employment transition services and more.

## **Monday, December 18, 2023:** *Preparing for College/Postsecondary Training and Education* by AW

- This workshop will offer insights into the differences between special education rights and legal standards in the k12 setting versus the postsecondary setting.

## **Monday, January 15, 2024:** *Preparing for Independent Living* by OCECD

- This workshop will explore independent and group living options, as well as skills development (budgeting, groceries, healthcare, etc.) and discuss how to work these goals and/or objectives into the IEP.

## **Tuesday, February 20, 2024:** *Transfer of Rights/Guardianship/Supported Decision Making for Adults With Disabilities* by Derek Graham, Esq. and ODE

- This workshop will explore the transfer of rights under IDEA at adulthood, guardianship, alternatives to guardianship, and supported decision making for adults with disabilities.

## **Monday, March 18, 2024:** *Social Security for Transition Age Youth* by DRO

- This workshop will help attendees understand Social Security eligibility and benefits, including the age 18 redetermination, continued payments, The Ticket to Work program, PASS plans, Student Earned Income Exclusion and other related concepts.

## **Monday, April 15, 2024:** *STABLE Accounts* by DRO

- This workshop will explain STABLE Accounts, including what they are, who can open an account, how to open an account, the benefits of maintaining an account and more.
